- Non-Western History: HI 315HI 317, HI 319, HI 345HI 363, HI 433.
- Pre-Modern History (prior to 1600 C.E.): HI 303 HI 304, HI 321 HI 362 HI 432

<sup>5</sup> SWAP Capstone may NOT double-count as Capstone for another major. Choose one of the following: IN 410 HI 491 HI 43X SWAP designated seminar, PO 491, PO 41X SWAP designated seminar. Note: HI 490 is a pre-requisite for HI 491 and PO 490 is a pre-requisite for PO 491

<sup>6</sup> Students must complete a 200 level HI course with a final grade of "C" or higher, or have instructor's permission to take 300 and 400 level HI courses.

<sup>8</sup> PO 202 Comparative Politics and PO 215 International Relations are prerequisites for 300 and 400 level PO courses in Comparative Politics and International Relations.
